

Christ has risen! He as risen indeed!


May one and all have a blessed Easter!



Wisconsin" Volunteer In Mission at Midwest Mission – March 2-7 25th year of ministry at Midwest Mission!!

A Wisconsin VIM team – made up of 18 participants ranging in age from 65 to 89 years old – labored for 422.5 hours at the Midwest Mission warehouse/ distribution center near Springfield Illinois. The group donated over \$800 to support the work done to bring assistance and caring nationally and throughout the world.

The first morning an assembly line was formed to prepare Blessing Kits (Rice meals). Throughout the week we sorted and packed: 468 UMCOR Cleaning Kits, 340 Student Kits, 450 Personal Dignity Kits, 240 Home Care Kits, 8 bed packs and 8 student desks (including sanding, polyurethane and wrapping.) Sorting donations that arrived while we were there was also an important task.

Asbury donated 95 baby sweaters, 51 one handle bags, 1 quilt, 5 sewing machines and 1 serger to Midwest Mission in Pawnee, IL.

The last day we blessed a shipment headed to North Carolina to help victims of the September 2024 hurricane and floods. It was so gratifying to know that what we had worked on was already on its way to help victims of a natural disaster. Earlier in the week we blessed a load of requested supplies headed for Guatemala.

Delicious meals were prepared by 2 team members. Everyone helped with dishes and led devotions after breakfast and supper. In the evening, folks read, worked puzzles, played card games or enjoyed conversation.

Everyone attended the Ash Wednesday service at Sugar Creek UMC.

The week of February 8-13 has been reserved for the 2026 VIM Journey to Midwest.

CELEBRATE A LIFE WELL LIVED


Remember the TV show "THIS IS YOUR LIFE?" A guest was surprised when persons from their past shared memories or tributes of their life.



Color me and then hang me up on the church bulletin board by the church office with the Easter wreath on it. Or drop it off at the church office.




