Application Criteria

Mandatory requirements. All applicants must:

- Be a **current member** of Nineteenth Street Baptist Church for at least one calendar year.
- Be enrolled in an undergraduate program at an accredited vocational school, college or university as a full-time student with the following minimum credit hours per semester:
 - **E. H. Moore Scholarship:** a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester of the current academic year. There may be exceptions for graduating seniors who have less than the minimum of 12 credit hours
 - **Love Pal Program:** a minimum of 9 credit hours per semester of the current academic year
- Submit fall enrollment verification.
- Submit a written response to questions **18-19** with the application form.
- Submit a current headshot photo.
- Submit a signed Love Pal Agreement of Participation, if applying for the Love Pal Program.

LOVE PAL AGREEMENT OF PARTICIPATION

Dear Love Pal Student,

As a member of the Nineteenth Street Baptist Church and currently enrolled in post-secondary studies, you are welcomed into the Love Pal Program. Your participation in this program will require you to maintain a full academic course load and enroll in at least nine (9) hours of studies each semester.
