From the Pastor's Pen...



Another year has ended and a new one is just getting started. The beginning of the year is a good time to reflect on how God has been among us. It's easy to see the end of the year as a time of regrets, of unkept promises, and missed opportunities. Instead, I choose to look at the many ways in which God had demonstrated that He has indeed been Emmanuel, "God with us!" Just walk with me through the year 2018 for a brief spell.

In the past year God has manifested His presence in the midst of grief and trials. We have had church families who have lost loved ones in the past year and have felt the love of God embodied in the members of First Baptist Church as we have rallied around them and poured out God's love on those walking through the valley of the shadow of death. We have experienced the comfort and strength of our God as we have faced many illnesses and dealt with various bouts of cancer throughout our church body. In each instance God has manifested His amazing love and His unlimited grace as He has raised up the body of Christ to come alongside each of those families walking through crises and bear their burdens with them.

Yes, God has been very present with us in times of great need. He has even shown up in remarkable ways bringing healing and recovery when the outcome looked very bleak. I rejoice in my God as I reflect on Donna Spellmeyer-Schnell's tumor in February, which the doctor thought was beyond hope and God demonstrated that He is Sovereign even over this. Time and time again God demonstrated that He is, indeed, "with us." We have had numerous church families who have been impacted by cancer diagnoses and yet in each case God has manifested His strength and His comfort to these families. God has raised up the body of Christ here at First Baptist to lift up these families in prayer and embody the love of Christ in ministering to them. Our God is not only "with us," he is amazing!

For many 2018 has been a challenging year of sickness and difficulty. Yet, even in this God has demonstrated that He is "with us." We have several families who have had ongoing health issues throughout the year and while many of them are still dealing with these issues, they feel the ongoing presence of God giving them peace and comfort. We have discovered that even in our pain and difficulties God is present with His mercy and His grace giving us the strength to endure what we are facing. Looking forward to the coming year let's continue to make it our goal, with His help, to live for God in UNITY!

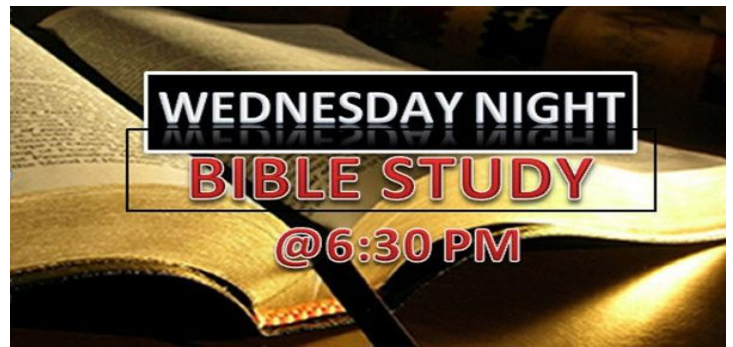

Just Older Youth with Joyful Hearts

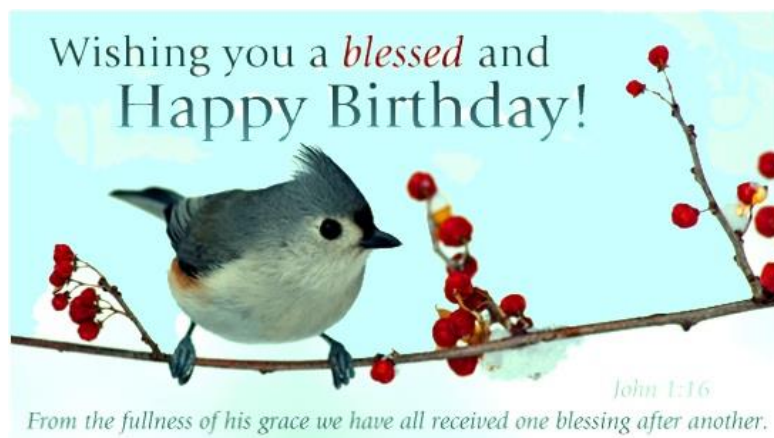
